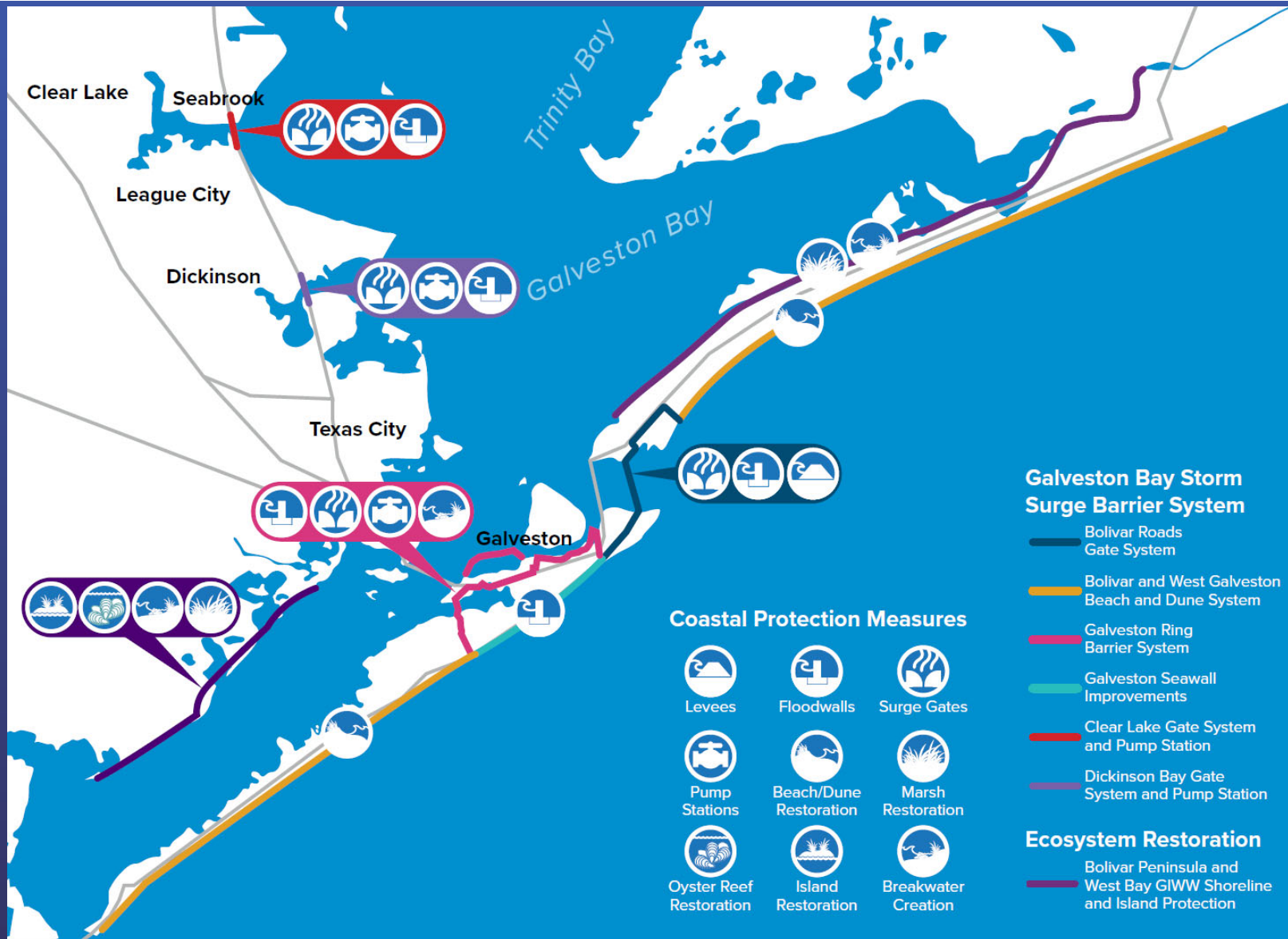

Procurement Overview

- Target RFQ Release Date: **July 11, 2025**
- RFQ-2025-1: Engineering Services for the Bolivar Roads Gate System
- RFQ-2025-2: Engineering Services for the Bolivar and West Galveston Beach and Dune System

Background

- GCPD serves as the non-federal sponsor for portions of the Coastal Texas Project (CTX)
- GCPD intends to perform select up-front planning, environmental, and engineering activities, as “work-in-kind”, in order to advance the development of two CTX features:
 - Bolivar Roads Gate System
 - Bolivar and West Galveston Beach and Dune System

- Question Deadline: *August 8, 2025*
- SOQ Due Date: *August 22, 2025 at 5:00pm*
- Interview Dates: Early September
- Selection at the October 8, 2025 Board Meeting
- Contract / Task Order Award at the December 10, 2025 Board Meeting

RFQ-2025-1: Overview

- Master Services Agreement to support development and design of the *Bolivar Roads Gate System*
- Initial task order focused on planning efforts related to up-front data collection, engineering, and environmental compliance actions
- Looking for a team capable of performing a wide range of potentially required services (planning, environmental, engineering)
- Work to be executed on a task order basis
- Subsequent work efforts could be performed by Respondent, USACE, or by separately procured consultants, as strategically advantageous

- Bolivar Roads Gate System feature may require design re-evaluation, including consideration of stakeholder input and environmental requirements
- Feature does not have full environmental clearance and will require a supplemental NEPA document
- Initial emphasis to be placed on developing phased implementation plan to advance the feature to 30% design and to secure full environmental clearance

RFQ-2025-2: Key Considerations

- Bolivar and West Galveston Beach and Dune System may require design re-evaluation, including consideration of stakeholder input and environmental requirements
- Feature does not have full environmental clearance and will require a supplemental NEPA document
- Sediment source for this feature has not yet been determined, requiring identification and environmental evaluation
- Initial emphasis to be placed on developing phased implementation plan to advance the feature to 30% design and to secure full environmental clearance

RFQ Requirements

- 50 pages total, including resumes and required forms
 - No specific formatting requirements (e.g. font sizes), but it must be legible and easy to follow
 - One (1) emailed copy (PDF), five (5) hard copies
- SOQ Sections:
 - Introductory Letter (4 pages)
 - Firm Profile (4 pages)
 - Project Approach (8 pages)
 - Key Personnel
 - Experience

SOQ Scoring

- Review of SOQ – 100 pts
 - Introductory Letter - 5 Points
 - Firm Profile - 15 Points
 - Project Approach - 25 Points
 - Key Personnel - 25 Points
 - Experience - 30 Points
- Short List Interview – 50 pts
- Board Evaluation / Recommendation

Short List Interview

- Anticipated: 1 hour in duration
 - 30 minutes for presentation from Respondent
 - 30 minutes for Q&A
- Participants:
 - GCPD Evaluation Committee (3)
 - Non-scoring Members
 - USACE
 - GLO
